Re: Notification of Mineral Exploration Program on Dahrouge Geological's Bus Property

Dear Mme. Morasse,

Dahrouge Geological Consulting Ltd. is planning to complete a surface mineral exploration program this summer/fall on the Bus Property, located in the James Bay Region of Quebec, within trapline VC26. Lithium is the primary commodity of interest with base and precious metals secondary commodities of interest.

The intent of this letter is to provide information on the planned activities as well as to ensure you have our contact information in case of any questions, comments, or concerns.

The field work is anticipated to consist primarily of ground prospecting and rock sampling, mapping, and soil sampling, as well as potential channel sampling and/or ground geophysical surveys. The specifics of the program are still being developed; however, is likely to consist of a 2-4 person field crew with exploration of the Property occurring over a 1-3 week period prior to snowfall.

Workers are expected to be lodged at an existing facility, anticipated to be the Mirage Lodge, and thus no camp would be required for this program. The Property will be accessed daily primarily by helicopter.
